Campus Parking




No student parking is allowed in the Faculty/Staff parking lots. Campus Police will issue tickets to students illegally parked there.

Solano Community College Moves Towards Becoming a Totally Smoke-Free College District

Solano Community College District (SCCD) is on the record as a SMOKE-FREE college environment.

Effective August 1, 2012 SCCD implemented its new smoke-free campus policy, which will allow smoking in limited areas throughout campus during the 2012-2013 academic year and will then completely transition to a NON-SMOKING campus effective July 1, 2013.

SCCD has joined over 30 California Community Colleges in becoming a healthier, safer, cleaner campus for all constituent groups involved; and all Universities of California will be smoke free by 2014.

At Solano Community College, a one-year transition period will occur, in which limited/temporary smoking areas will be designated, the new policy will be advertised, and information about Smoking Cessation courses will be posted in the Student Health Center and around campus and in the ASSC Newsletter.

Temporary campus smoking designations include the following:

- Fairfield Campus: North/West corner of the tennis courts near Building 1800A
- Vacaville Campus: Rear courtyard
- Vallejo Campus: Rear courtyard

Student ID Cards

Student ID cards are **still only \$5.00** and can be purchased online at *MySolano*. They are good for various merchant discounts, discounts at Solano College sporting events, and ASSC events. ID cards are required to use the library, computer labs and bookstore.

Student ID cards are **valid for 9 consecutive semesters** (including summer) or 3 academic years. They must be validated each semester at no cost. Come to Room 1425 for a new sticker for the current semester.

Planned Parenthood Express Clinics We will be

serving students every Wednesday from 12:30
a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Student Health Center in Room 1409. All services are confidential.

Services include: birth control (Nuva ring, patch, pills), HIV screening test, STD testing, free pregnancy testing, free condoms & emergency contraception.

Tuberculin (TB) Skin Testing is offered by appointment, Mondays & Tuesdays 10:00 a.m. to noon, Monday, 4:00-5:00 p.m., and Tuesday, 5:00-6:00 p.m. You must return in 48-72 hours post test to have the Tuberculin skin test read and receive your record of testing.

Health Screening exams are available at the Student Health Center for Children's Program students. Drop-in or make an appointment for your Health Screening.

Medications: Free over-the-counter medications for common conditions are available free to students at the Student Health Center. Medications include: generic choices of decongestants, pain medications, cough suppressants, decongestants, lubricating eye drops, burn gel, & more.

Screenings/testing: Health, diabetic, vision, hearing and urine screenings, are free to students.

Lactation Station – Privacy for breastfeeding students to breastfeed their babies or pump milk. Stop by and we'll find a comfortable place for you.
