Solano Community College's Executive Vice President to Become CEO of Mendocino-Lake Community College

FAIRFIELD, CA, DECEMBER 13, 2012: Solano Community College (SCC) congratulates Mr. Arturo Reyes, SCC Executive Vice President (EVP) of Academic & Student Affairs, on receiving a unanimous 5-0 Mendocino-Lake Community College Board of Trustees vote, to become their District's seventh Superintendent/President since 1972. After serving as SCC's EVP for the past two and a half years, Reyes has accepted the position effective Monday, January 7, 2013.

"I am thrilled to accept the Superintendent/President position at Mendocino College, although it



saddens me to leave Solano Community College. At SCC, I made many new friends, met countless talented students, worked with brilliant colleagues, and benefitted from the guidance and support of the College Trustees and Superintendent/President Laguerre. Under their leadership, our college community has overcome accreditation challenges, addressed budget shortfalls, strengthened academic programs, and emerged with remarkable community support- as evidenced by the recent passage of Measure Q. Because of this experience, I am better prepared to work collaboratively with all constituency groups to enhance the educational opportunities for the residents of Mendocino and Lake Counties as Superintendent/President at Mendocino College," contributed Reyes.
